THE PERFECT BOTTOM BLADE

Last winter I was restoring a 12" Ransomes Patent Chain Automaton but all the time I was cleaning and repainting the metal bits I was aware of a hurdle that had to be overcome before I could finish the project: the bottom blade was rusted away. This was crucial for the restoration because my intention has always been to use the mower at events, perhaps in conjunction with my mower pusher (that's another story).

I've been aware of Garfitts in Sheffield for some time and had recommended them to other collectors on a number of occasions. For those who don't know, Garfitts supplies bottom blades and hundreds of other items for all sorts of new and older mower to businesses throughout the UK. Of course I could have called them to find out if they could help but knew they prefer to deal with "accounts" or "trade customers". But it struck me that other people in the club might need the sort of item they supplied and perhaps we should be organising some kind of service. By coincidence Richard Jones also had the same idea and suggested it to me at the Annual Rally in May. I told him about my bottom blade (with the basic measurements) and he managed to get a few other orders from members over the weekend. A few weeks later, we had set up an account and Richard had placed the first order. The items duly arrived, including the bottom blade, and I was able to finish off the mower. All I needed to do was drill holes in the blade in the right position, countersink them and insert the screws that Garfitts also sent. It was as simple as that. I'd already reground the cylinder so once the mower is reassembled (one of this winter's projects) I should have a fully operational 100 year old mower to show in 2006.

Garfitts supplied Richard and me with a CD containing a complete catalogue of their items. All you need to do is contact Richard (rather than me thanks) and he will be able to check whether the item is available, confirm the price and place the order on your behalf. Once the item has been delivered to the club we'll work out the final price including postage and send it to you. In addition to the parts in the catalogue they can supply almost any bottom blade to your own specification. As a guide, the 12" bottom blade for the Patent Chain Automaton cost around £15 including the screws and postage which I think represents tremendously good value.
